

We are **ALL** strongly advised to wear face coverings in enclosed public spaces including places of worship. The Diocese advises that face coverings **should** be worn by **ALL** those attending mass, remembering that they are mainly intended to protect other people, not the wearer, from COVID-19 and that they are not a replacement for physical distancing and regular hand washing.
