place until 13th September.

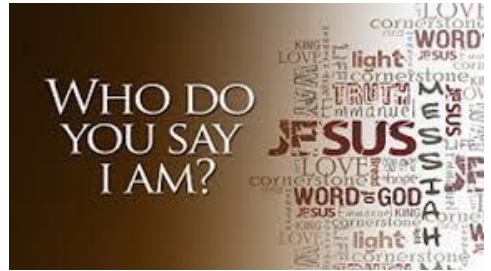
All forms are available now so that there is enough time to collate the
