Macmillan. **THANK YOU!**

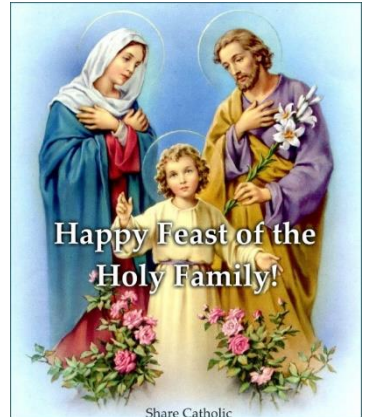
