
A gentle reminder that we will be holding an **Ash Wednesday Mass on Wednesday beginning at 7pm** (our usual time for this service) Ash - this can be made at home but with care. Use last year's Palm Crosses and burn them over a plate or dish. They will burn relatively slowly but **you should take care in any case so that safety is maintained.** Once all of the wooden stem has burned and the embers have gone cold, crush the ash as much as you can. Then on Wednesday add a drop or so of water (please do not pour water on the ash) and mix the ash until it has formed a paste.

Then on Wednesday either Fr Croft or Fr Paul will explain what we will do. If you would like to join us for this very special service do let us know.


