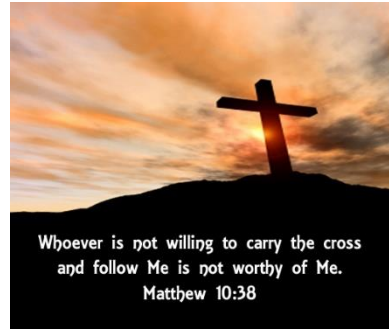
*After Sunday's Solemn High Mass, Coffee is served in the Croft.
