Message from our PCC Treasurer

**Please read...this is NOT just for tax payers,
it is relevant to everyone.**

GIFT AID -

If you pay tax on your income or savings, your donations to church can be made under the Gift Aid scheme. This makes no difference to you however for church, it increases the value of your donations by 25% so every £1 becomes £1.25. If you use the envelope scheme or pay directly into the bank via transfer or standing order, please ask Tina for a form if you are able to Gift Aid your donations.

We are also able to claim Gift Aid on any cash donations given during the weekly collection, again increasing each £1 to £1.25. Therefore, as a non taxpayer, putting your donation directly into the collection bag and not using the envelopes is better for church.

Examples:

Fred is a tax payer and pays £10 per month by standing order. With Gift Aid, church receives £12.50.

Mary is a non taxpayer and puts £3 per week into her envelope. Church gets £3. If she stops using envelopes and puts her £3 cash into the collection bag, church receives £3.75.

This is a way of increasing our income at no personal cost to anyone. Please consider if you are eligible to Gift Aid your donation, or whether you can donate in cash instead of using the envelope scheme.
